This is the time to form teams to ensure your child's success. We do that by teachers and families collaborating to support our Noble students. Our parent teacher conferences are coming up and it's time for us to sit down and work on supporting our kids and their educational experience. Here are a few things to remember about parent teacher conferences:

## Before the conference

Review your child's schoolwork, write down any questions, and think about your child's strengths and weaknesses so you can talk about them with the teacher.

## **During the conference**

Feel free to offer any information that you think will add to your child's academic progress. Ask the teacher about his/her plans to support your child's academic improvements. Ask how you can assist to support these improvements. Talk about how your exchange of information with the teacher to monitor your child's progress is doing in class.

## After the conference

Talk to your child about the conference. Be positive and point out the strengths you and the teacher discussed. Talk about academic areas you will help improve and make plans with your child about how you will do it together. Let the teacher know how the plan is working and call the school if you need additional help.

This is also the time of year that we reflect on what makes us thankful. I am very thankful to all Noble families for sending us your very best students every day and allowing us to be a part of their daily learning. I know I am especially Thankful for our office staff, all of our teachers and all of our support staff. This includes Yard Duties, lunch staff, Ms. Ryan, PTA, our paras, our custodial staff and all those who make it possible for us to have a great time with the kids every day.

## Traffic Issues: Drive Safely

you have any questions.

As a staff we have concerns about the before and after school traffic around Noble School. Please consider the safety of every child when you are driving near our school and respect our efforts to keep everyone safe. Please follow all staff directions in and around campus as we are doing our best to keep everyone safe as well as set a good example for our kids. In addition, please follow the designated pattern of traffic flow when dropping off and picking up students that was designed for the safety of our children. This included right turns **only** out of our parking lot and turn around. It is important that everyone observe the **no parking** rule in the drive through area in front of the school and along all red curbs in the street. Please follow correct directional parking along our street. If you are dropping/loading your child off in the front turn-around, please make sure they unload or load on the right side of the car. This is for their safety and yours. Parking in this area and opening driver side doors causes an unsafe condition for cars passing through to pick up or drop off students.

Please do not walk in our parking lots where traffic moves. Please use the walkway along the fence or the side walk and not walk in the middle of the driveway or behind the parked cars. Also please do not park in the handicap spots if you do not have handicap placards. We want those spots open for those who need them. We want to model good safety decisions for our students. Thanks for your cooperation in helping our school become a safer place.

## **COVID Testing Information:**

Noble will have onsite covid testing for students every Tuesday. This is at no cost to parents. This testing may be used for routine weekly testing, parent directed testing, or for when students have symptoms. We ask that you test at our school site only. We are not sending kids to other school sites for testing. Students can only be tested with parent consent and a registration through the online system. This is a rapid test and results are sent to the email the parent registered with and not sent to us at the school site. Results are typically given in less than 30 minutes.
