HISTORY AND BACKGROUND

- Founded in early '90s by parents
- Originally at several schools, now just Noble
- All K-3 children in Berryessa are eligible
- Parents encouraged to volunteer in their child's classroom and our school
- Average: families volunteer ~25 hours or more/year & make a tax-deductible donation

PPP: A non-profit corporation

- 501(c)(3) organization
- Donations are tax deductible
- Parents & teachers on PPP Board
- Donations directly support students
- Surplus funds follow students

Parent Jobs K - 3rd

- Work with children 1-on-1 or in groups
- Lead centers about reading, math, science
- Lead/assist with garden & cooking lessons



Outside the classroom

- Coordinate field trip drivers
- Prepare school materials at home
- Shop for classroom supplies
- Organize photos & videos
- Schedule trips and classroom visitors

Why donate money?

- Extra funds provide enriching field trips and transportation
- Extra materials & projects enhance curriculum



Why donate money?

- Provide enriching activities for the school community or grade-levels to share



Why donate your time?

- Parents, teachers, and children working together provides a stronger sense of community and positive interactions
- Smaller adult/child ratios increases comprehension and retention



Why donate your time?

- Visitors and guest teachers bring other perspectives, expertise, and experiences
- Students see that education is important when their parents are involved in learning



CURRICULUM

- All classes use state-adopted materials--Common Core State Standards (CCSS) & NGSS (science)
- Students take district & state tests
- Field trips enhance learning
- Differentiation through smaller groups

Process/Application

- 1) Attend PPP Meeting or View slide deck on the Noble Website
- 2) Enroll in Berryessa with your homeschool for Kindergarten
- 3) Submit or email completed application to Noble by 3:30 PM, March 17

Application Process, continued

4) Apply for intra-district transfer if Noble isn't your home school.

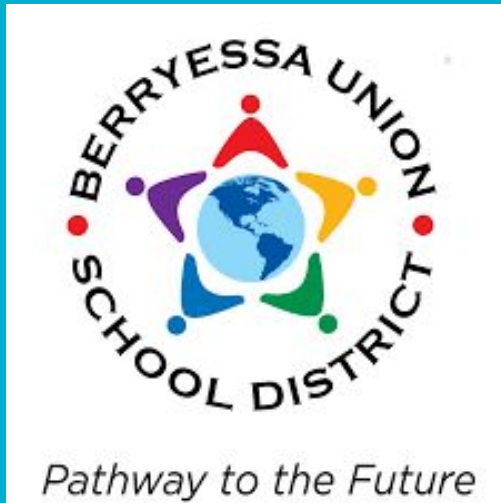
- There is a second page to the application. This page is the Intra-District Transfer form. You need to fill this out only if Noble is not your homeschool.
