We are plugging along...Chromebooks and all. I hope things are starting to settle more for our students at home. As we continue to move through the school year here are a couple reminders:

1. Tech issues happen. More so now than ever. If your student is having tech issues, you can log onto the district website. Under the Digital Learning Parent Portal, you can fill out for tech support a form. Here is the link as well <https://sites.google.com/busd.net/dlp/home>

2. If for some reason the tech issue cannot be resolved with our IT department, you may contact our school librarian Ms. Ryan at cryan@busd.net and she can check a different device out for your student. Then you can stop by Noble and switch the device out. Just a note, we only check out Chromebooks.

3. Teachers have tech issues sometimes too. If you are trying to log on and your teacher is having a tech, issue please be patient. They are working hard to get on as well. If for any reason, the teacher needs to delay class by more than a couple of minutes you will receive an email from our front office notifying you of this.

4. If your student is having an issue logging on just for a day (not consistently) please send an email to the teacher to let them know. A side note...most teachers are not teaching from campus and those that are only coming in a day here and there. We cannot call their classroom to let them know and we cannot handout their personal cell/ house numbers. This will not affect your child's attendance as long as we are notified from the family.
